CONTEST RULES

1. Teams may cook with any type of wood and/ or charcoal. Other flammables (propane, compressed or liquid gas, etc.) may be used within the cooker ONLY to START the INITIAL fire. Flammables may not be used within the cooker once the meat has been placed there. Flammables may be used outside and away from the cooker to make additional coals. Local fire and safety laws may prevent the use of any type of gas anywhere on the grounds at any time, and, if so, these laws will prevail.

Electrical devices may be used within the cooker as long as they do not directly generate heat. Approved devices include rotisseries, fans and delivery systems for approved fuels (e.g. Traeger grills). Electric smokers, holding ovens, containers or any other devices with heat producing electrical coils are not allowed.

Meat for the contest may be fresh or frozen. Meat may not be pre-cooked, sauced, spiced, injected, marinated, cured in any way, or otherwise pre-treated prior to the official meat inspection. Meat must be maintained at a temperature below 40 degrees Fahrenheit prior to cooking, and at or above 140 degrees Fahrenheit after cooking.

- a. A Pork Rib entry is defined as the portion containing the ribs and further classified as a spare rib or loin rib portion. Country style ribs are not a valid entries.
 - b. A Pork Shoulder entry is defined as the portion containing the arm bone, shank bone, and a portion of the blade bone. The pork ham considered a shoulder entry contains the hind leg bone. Boston butts may be used instead. Picnic shoulders are not allowed.
2. The "Smokin' @ The Eagle" Barbecue Cooking Contest will be held at Glen Eagle Golf Course, Naval Support Activity Mid-South, Millington, Tennessee Oct. 4 & 5 2019.
3. Judging of the categories in the "Smokin' @ the Eagle" Barbecue Cooking contest will follow a blind judging procedure.
4. You may garnish entries with Greenery, such as Green lettuce, kale or parsley in the bottom of the tray to set your entry on.

CONTESTANT RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Each contestant competing shall supply all of his/her own meat, cooking devices (portable stoves, wood, or charcoal, etc.-NO GAS) utensils, preparation tables, etc. A regulation cooking area will be provided to contestants. All contestants MUST adhere to all electrical, fire and other codes set forth by city, county, state and federal officials.
2. ELECTRICITY AND WATER ARE AVAILABLE IN LIMITED LOCATIONS. Please bring a container(s) to transport water, an extension cord of at least 100 ft for power. You will be required to have in your area a bucket of chlorinated water for sterilization. Ice will be sold on premises for \$1.50 per bag.
3. PORT-A-POTTIES ARE AVAILABLE FOR ADDITIONAL \$85 FEE.
4. No food grease can be disposed of on the ground. All grease shall be containerized. Grease that is in a liquid state shall be disposed of in the grease tank located on site.

ACCEPTANCE

1. APPLICATION: entry fees required with submission of entry form. The entry fee reserves a 30' x 30' team area. See attached entry form for all category selections. We will accommodate cooking rigs and trappings based on space availability. Do not reserve a 30' x 30' area to erect a 20' x 20' tent as the tent ropes would not be within your area. The Fire Marshall will have strict control regarding this rule. Frontage on 30'x 40' or larger area will be at the discretion of the MWR Department.
2. CHECKS should be made payable to Morale, Welfare and Recreation Department. Refunds will not be made once a contestant is accepted.
3. **While teams may accept "donation or tips", The sale of food or alcohol is strictly prohibited.**
4. **Deadline to enter is Friday, Sept. 27, 2019.**
