Glen Eagle Cup Events

Saturday, Nov. 16 3 Club x 3 Cup Tournament

This event is an individual 18 hole stroke play event in which players will compete using only 3 clubs of their choice and playing to 3 pins on each green.

Each player will be allowed their putter which will not count towards the 3 club limit.

Glen Eagle Cup Events

Saturday, Jan. 11

Penn 'A' Palooza Scramble

This event is a 3-person modified scramble event.

Each player will tee off and the team will select the best shot, here is the twist. The players shot that was selected will sit out the next shot leaving only the 2 players.

Play will continue with a player dropping and 2

Players hitting until the ball is holed.

Saturday, Feb. 15 2-Person Switch-A-Roo

This is a 2-person alternate shot event in which both balls will be in play throughout the hole. Both players will tee off, from this point you will hit your partners next shot.

Teams will alternate shots on each ball until it is holed. The team score will be the lower of the 2 scores. Teams will use 25% of the total team handicap for the Net Division, we will also have a Gross division.

Saturday, March 14 Players Championship Points Event

This event will be an Individual 18 hole points event against the players handicap. Each player *will pick a PGA Tour player* that makes the cut at the 2020 Players Championship, in addition you will be paired with another player here at Glen Eagle.

Prizes will be awarded for both your "Glen Eagle"

Monday, April 1

Individual Match Play begins

Players will compete in an individual match play bracket.

Saturday, April 11 Masters Points Event

This event will be an Individual 18 hole points event against the players handicap. Each player *will pick a PGA Tour player* that makes the cut at the 2020 Masters, in addition you will be paired with another player here at Glen Eagle. Prizes will be awarded for both your "Glen Eagle" pairing and your "Masters" pairing. Points will be awarded based on "Masters" pairings.

Saturday, May 2

Superintendents "Jay's" Revenge Scramble

This event is an 18 hole, two person team scramble event. If you thought some of our pin placements were questionable before, just wait until you see the pins for this event. Our greens staff will set the pins on every slope possible for this event.

Saturday, May 16

PGA Championship Points Event

This event will be an Individual 18 hole points event against the players handicap. Each player will pick a PGA Tour player that makes the cut at the 2020 PGA Championship, in addition you will be paired with another player here at Glen Eagle.

Friday, June 26

Red, White, & Blue Scramble

A 4th of July tradition at Glen Eagle GC. Each team will consist of 4 players of any skill level, no handicaps required.

There will be tee sequences set for the event alternating between red tees, white tees, and blue tees.

August 8 & 9

**Glen Eagle Golf Course Club Championship **

This is the last event of the Glen Eagle Cup Regular Season.

Players will compete in Individual medal Play for bragging rights as the top golfer at Glen Eagle GC.
Players can enter in 4 divisions:

Championship, Tournament, Senior,

and Super Senior/Ladies.

Glen Eagle Playoff events

Glen Eagle Cup Points will be adjusted for the playoff push at the start of the 1st event.

Saturday, Sept. 5 1st Playoff Event (Top 100) Individual Drop Tournament

This is an Individual event in which the player will have to "DROP" a club after each hole until they reach 3 total clubs, putter will stay in the bag at all times. Once a club is "DROPPED" it can no longer be used for play.

Saturday, Sep. 19 2nd Playoff Event (Top 70)

Reverse 18 Tournament

This is an Individual event in which our Top 70 players will compete playing the course backwards!

We will play an 18 hole medal play competition playing each hole in reverse.

Saturday, Oct. 3 3rd Playoff Event (Top 30) Flag Tournament

This is an Individual Event in which players will have an allotted number of stroked based on their handicap. Once the player reaches their number of strokes they will place their FLAG at this point on the course. The player whose FLAG is the farthest on the course will be the winner.

The Glen Eagle Cup Awards Presentation Dinner will be held at the conclusion of the 3rd Playoff Event on October 3.

All Top 100 Players are invited to attend.
